#### **CHAPTER V**

##### **❖ GENERAL GUIDELINES**

1. Each college can send only 1 team of maximum 14 students.
2. Each individual can only participate in a maximum of 3 events. The Choices available are :
  - A. Choose any one event out of Moot Court Competition & Parliamentary Debate competition.
  - B. Choose any 2 events out of remaining 5 categories.
- **Note-** If you have not selected any event from Moot Court or Parliamentary Debate then you can choose 3 events out of the remaining 5 events.
3. The teams will get pick up facility by IIL on 21<sup>st</sup> October 2016 morning 09:00hrs to 12:00hrs from Indore Railway Station only. Alternately, the students can directly report to the reception counter, IIL, Indore. For further clarification you can call the transportation coordinators.
4. Boarding and lodging will be provided to the participants from 21<sup>st</sup> October 2016 to 24<sup>th</sup> October Morning 10:00 A.M. only.
5. Host College will provide meals from 21<sup>st</sup> October 2016 (lunch) to 24<sup>th</sup> October 2016 Morning (Breakfast).
6. The language of communication in all the events shall be strictly restricted to English except street play.
7. All the participants should report at the venue to their respective competition coordinators half an hour before the starting of the competition. The team not reporting on time will be accountable for the consequences.



## *General Guidelines*

8. The participating teams are requested to send registration forms accompanied by DD latest by 5<sup>th</sup> October 2016 positively. In case of any mishandling by the Postal / courier services IIL shall not be held responsible.
9. The organizer reserves the right to change the venue/date any rule and/or frame any additional rule.
10. Students shall wear formal uniform (white shirt, black blazer, black tie, black trousers, white socks, black shoes/ballerinas) in all official occasions which include:
  - A. Inaugural and Valedictory Ceremony of the event.
  - B. All the Competitions.
11. Any type of nuisance created by participants in campus/competition venue will lead to the disqualification of the team.
12. The participants should ensure that strict discipline is maintained at IIL campus and participant should not leave the campus/competition venue without prior permission from event co-coordinator.
13. College identity cards are must for all students.
14. The competition venue for all events will be the IIL campus.
15. All the participants must send their two latest passport size photograph along with Registration Form.
16. All the participants must ensure the safety of their belongings .In case of any mishap IIL shall not be held accountable.
